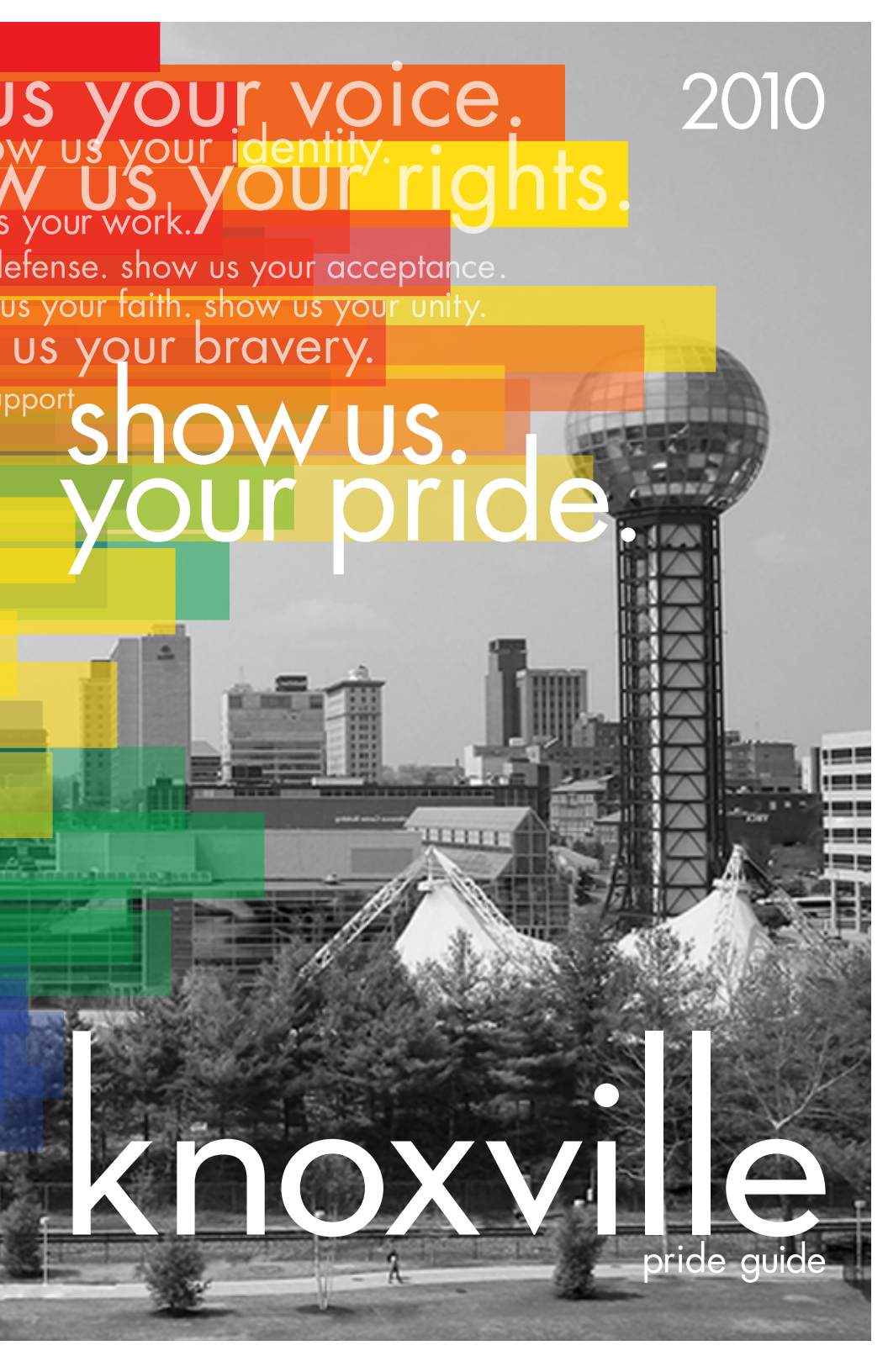

In a highly segregated Knoxville community, Mr. Person was welcomed and eventually joined the church, making TVUUC one of the first integrated congregations in Knoxville. Today's sign includes only two changes: the word Universalist, added in 1991, and the rainbow flag designating this church as a Welcoming Congregation, added in 1993. In the original spirit of welcoming and inclusion, we open our arms to all who would worship with us.

Programming Committee Chair


