

AN ALBUM OF THE SAME NAME WAS RELEASED LATER THAT YEAR ON EPIC RECORDS, AND WAS CERTIFIED DOUBLE PLATINUM IN THE UNITED STATES. FOL-LOWING IT WAS A CHRISTMAS ALBUM CLASSIC CHRISTMAS AND DARE TO DREAM, BOTH OF WHICH WERE CERTIFIED GOLD. HE EXITED EPIC'S ROSTER AND SIGNED TO IMAGE ENTERTAINMENT IN 2005 RELEASING EVERYTHING AND MORE.

IN 2006. HE RELEASED THE SELF-TITLED BILLY GILMAN. AFTER A NUMBER OF NON-CHARTING RELEASES FROM 2006 TO 2009. FOLLOWED BY A HIATUS TILL 2013. HE RETURNED IN 2014 WITH A NEW SINGLE "SAY YOU WILL".

IN NOVEMBER OF 2014 BILLY CAME OUT To the world as an openly gay artist!

WEST FAMILY CHANGING UP MARKET SQUARE RESTAURANTS

BREAK OUT THE BUBBLES. Grab some glitter. Knoxville Uncorked is coming to town – downtown, to be exact.

The West family is revamping Oodies Uncorked, everything from the menu to the service, with the help of new culinary director Terri Roberts. Knoxville Uncorked, located at 18-28 Market Square, will feature new menus and wine/beer pairings.

Roberts, a Knoxville native who previously worked for James Beard award-winning chefs in Chicago, also will do extensive staff training at the restaurant.

"I envision Uncorked becoming more trattoriastyle, a place with rustic Italian food that brings friends and families together," she explains.

Scott West, whose parents, Jim and Vada, own Knoxville Uncorked, adds, "Our intention is to make sure Terri has everything she needs to take our kitchens to the very top of Knoxville's food scene."

The West kitchens also will include Market. House Café, 36 Market Square.

Roberts will oversee the opening of the café, featuring a charcuterie and cheese counter, fresh sandwiches, juice bar and coffee shop. She calls it a locally provided grocery market.

Other additions on the horizon for the West family of businesses on historic Market Square include:

A wider range of gourmet pizzas at Preservation Pub, 28 Market Square

A kitchen at Scruffy City Hall, located two doors down from Preservation Pub. Reviewers on Yelp describe Scruffy City Hall as a "cool, cool music venue" and "great place for hanging out and having a drink, great beer selection and appetizers." That's not all.

"Believe it or not, Bernadette just bought a brand new gourmet hot dog cart from New York City, so we'll be slinging delicious Scruffy Dogs at 4 a.m. too," says West.

The energy, enthusiasm and creativity of Bernadette and Scott West appealed to Roberts and factored in her decision to throw her chef's hat into the ring of family businesses.

Born and reared in Knoxville, she graduated from Kendall College in Chicago with a degree in applied science, culinary arts. She did her internship at Wish Restaurant in Miami.

She then worked for three James Beard award winners at North Pond and Avec restaurants in Chicago, followed by a James Beard award nominee at Table in Asheville, N.C.

Her resume also includes positions as executive chef at The Southern Kitchen & Bar in Asheville and sous-chef working with a French master

chef at Patrick Properties hospitality group in Charleston, S.C.

"I am focused on farm to table and am interested in all styles of cooking," says the Knoxville Uncorked culinary director.

"I have always admired Scott and Bernadette. They had a vision of the potential my hometown had and have worked tirelessly to make that vision a reality. I have seen so much growth downtown since I left 11 years ago. I feel honored to now become a part of Knowile's continued growth."

The feeling is mutual. As Scott West says, "Her vision was the same as ours – that's why this partnership is gonna rock?"

For more than 20 years, the West family, including Scott's sisters, Paula and Sandy, has developed historic buildings and opened

The "scruffy" slam has served as a railying point for Knoxvillians ever since. For instance, the West's funky retail shop Earth to Old City has catered to local pride with "Keep Knoxville Scruffy" T-shirts, sweatshirts and bumper stickers.
