WHAT TO EXPECT WITH PRIDEFEST THIS YEAR!

Thanks to the strong LGBTQ+ community, our allies, and the hard work of Knox Pride to bring PrideFest to Mary Costa Plaza and Performance Lawn (Knoxville Coliseum Lawn). This location allows us bring you even more sponsors, new opportunities, and greater diversity in vendors and entertainment.

Libations

As in previous years, water & soft drinks are available for purchase from food vendors. Knox Pride will be the sole provider of alcohol. If you wish to drink you must show a valid id and purchase a \$1 wristband and drink tickets. We take cash or credit for ticket sales. Buy a VIP pass & treat yourself to the tented VIP area for free food, an open bar, A/C & get up close with the entertainers.

The "Red Tape"

You must be 21 to drink alcohol and you can't bring your own (no matter how old you are). Sorry, it's the law. Entry into the park requires going through a security checkpoint where police will search all bags. Anyone attempting to carry in outside alcohol, weapons, or firearms will not be permitted to enter. Coolers are not permitted, however, small umbrellas are allowed. Anyone caught giving a minor alcohol will be removed from the premises immediately.

Parking

For Pridefest the most convenient parking garages will be next to the coliseum for \$5. There are several city operated parking lots in the downtown area that are free to park on weekends, but we strongly suggest you check the city online parking guides and plan ahead. Also, checkout the KAT schedule to help you get around downtown.

Emergencies

Knox Pride will have uniformed security and EMS available to handle emergencies. Please follow all instructions from festival staff and security. In the event of extreme weather, shelter is available in the coliseum garage.

ADA

Knox Pride continues to try to make the festival as ADA accessible as possible. Handicap parking is located in all three parking garages next to the lawn, including ramps to get to the festival grounds. The festival grounds has concreted areas throughout but please be aware that many parts of the festival are on grass. If you are in need of assistance, please feel free to speak with any Staff Member. A golf cart is available for transport across the grounds, if needed.



Innovative synths and upbeat rhythms are the signature sounds that drive Hudson K, Knoxville's premier electro-rock duo, featuring Christina Horn (vocals/synths) and Nate Barrett (drums). For the past decade, Hudson K has explored the intersection of electronica and classical music, composing sonic tapestries that

From there, Yara began traveling all over the world, showcasing her amazing and unique talent as a drag queen, performer, and designer. She was invited back to RuPaul's Drag Race for the All Stars edition and was paired with Alexis Mateo. Since the show aired, Yara moved to Las Vegas to become better known in the world of fashion and to continue growing as a performer. Yara was named Miss Skin Wars 2016 from the highly popular Game Show Network "Skin Wars".

Once he got his first record player at age 2, his love of music intensified. I guess it helped that I sang to him constantly, and that when he got up every morning we danced while I sang Be-Bop- A-Lula, You're my Baby. Thus, I started calling him Be-Bop. I am quite sure he didn't like this much when I called him that as a teenager. Now it is a sweet memory that we both laugh at. However, as an elementary student, he began to play sports. He played baseball, football, soccer and basketball. Music was something for listening to and singing along with. He never thought he could sing, although myself and many of his friends had heard him and knew he had a nice voice. He played trombone in the junior high school band, but gave it up to play high school basketball. I owned an old Martin guitar which I had played in high school and college. Luke picked around on this guitar, but never got totally interested in playing. He learned a few basic chords from me, but it wasn't until 2002 that he actually stole my guitar and began to take lessons from a girl he thought was cute, thinking this would be a good way to meet her. He ended up liking the guitar more than the girl. Time passed and Luke began attending performances by Paul "Tall Paul" Bobal. Many shows later Paul offered Luke a lesson, and this developed into a friendship as well as mentorship. Luke had never sung in public before, but suddenly realized he could. He began to learn songs, and began his career by opening for Tall Paul a few times. He eventually gave me back my guitar and invested in his own equipment. You can find Luke playing most all the time. When he is not performing, he is practicing. I told him the guitar had grown to his hip. Many of his high school classmates find it amazing that this high school jock is singing for a living. They are all amazed at his vocal and guitar ability.
