

No union is more profound than marriage, for it embodies the highest ideals of love, fidelity, devotion, sacrifice, and family. In forming a marital union, two people become something greater than once they were. As some of the petitioners in these cases demonstrate, marriage embodies a love that may endure even past death. It would misunderstand these men and women to say they disrespect the idea of marriage. Their plea is that they do respect it, respect it so deeply that they seek to find its fulfillment for themselves. Their hope is not to be condemned to live in loneliness, excluded from one of civilization's oldest institutions. They ask for equal dignity in the eyes of the law. The Constitution grants them that right. The judgment of the Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit is reversed.

It is so ordered.

With those words in the decision of Obergefell v. Hodges (plaintiffs including a couple from Knoxville), the high court struck down all federal and state laws limiting marriage to opposite sex couples. It short: Love Won!

#### WHAT TO EXPECT WITH PRIDEFEST THIS YEAR!

Thanks to the strong lgbtq community, their allies, and the hard work of the east tennessee equality council, knoxville pridefest will be back at the south lawn of the world's fair park. This location will let us bring even more sponsors, new opportunities, and greater diversity in vendors and entertainment this year.

#### Libations

As in previous years water & soft drinks are available for purchase from food vendors. Knoxville pridefest will be the sole provider of alcohol. If you wish to drink you must show a valid id and purchase a \$1 wristband and drink tickets. We take cash or credit for ticket sales, but there are no atm's on site so plan ahead! Buy a vip pass & treat yourself to the tented vip area for free food, an open bar, a/c & get up close with the entertainers.

#### The "Red Tape"

You must be 21 to drink alcohol, and you can't bring your own (no matter how old you are). Sorry, it's the law. Entry into the park requires going through a security checkpoint. The police will search all bags. Coolers are not permitted. Anyone attempting to carry in outside alcohol, weapons, or firearms will not be permitted to enter.

#### **Parking**

Pridefest cannot assist you in finding a parking spot. There are several city operated parking lots in the downtown area that are free to park on weekends but we strongly suggest you check the city and utk's online parking guides and plan ahead. #### **Emergencies**

Knoxville pridefest will have uniformed security and first aid available to handle emergencies. Please follow all instructions from festival staff and security. In the event of extreme weather, shelter is available in the 11th street parking garage.

Chely Wright rose to fame as a commercial country singer in the 90's, having released eight studio albums selling more than 1,000,000 copies in the U.S. and charted more than 15 singles on the Billboard charts. On the strength of her debut album in 1994, the Academy of Country Music named Chely Top New Female Vocalist of 1995. Her first hit came in 1997 with "Shut Up and Drive" followed two years later by her first number one single, "Single White Female" and in 2005, the zeitgeist – capturing hit "The Bumper of My S.U.V."

Chely just completed a new studio album titled I Am The Rain, recorded at Sunset Sound in Los Angeles featuring guest performances by Emmylou Harris, Rodney Crowell and the Milk Carton Kids. Produced by renowned musician and producer Joe Henry (Bonnie Raitt, Elvis Costello, Loudon Wainwright III, Ani DiFrano, Betty LaVette), the much anticipated album will be released in autumn of 2016.

In 2010, Chely Wright released her eighth album, "Lifted Off the Ground" produced by Rodney Crowell, revealing a dramatic artistic transformation and emerging as a singer songwriter of the first order. The album would never have come to be were it not for an equally dramatic personal transformation which she candidly and painstakingly documented in a memoir entitled "Like Me" published by Random House the same day. Chely made history by being the first country music star to come out publicly as gay. Wright has cited among her reasons for coming out a concern with bullying and hate crimes toward LGBT people, particularly LGBT youth,

and the damage to her life caused by "hiding".

In the midst of a tumultuous political climate about the civil rights of the LGBT community, the 2011 award-winning documentary "Wish Me Away" was released. The critically acclaimed film chronicles Chely Wright's journey growing up and then moving to Nashville to become a country singer. It portrays her preparing for the day she comes out publically and then depicts the aftermath of her decision.

Chely Wright's soul-searching has led to many rewards. The LGBT role model serves as the national spokesperson for the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network (GLSEN) and speaks out against school bullying. Wright founded The LIKEME® Organization, a nonprofit organization that provides assistance, resources and education to LGBT individuals and their family & friends. Wright also founded The LIKEME® Lighthouse, an education and community center for gay youth in Kansas City, MO. The Lighthouse recently celebrated its fourth anniversary with a sold out fundraising gala at the Folly Theater featuring Wanda Sykes, Judy Gold, Wendy Liebman and Steve Grand.

Chely Wright is married to activist and author Lauren Blitzer-Wright, who is currently Director of Marketing for Sony Entertainment. As of 2013, the two became parents to twin boys. In December 2014, Wright performed an original Christmas carol at the annual National Christmas Tree Lighting ceremony on the White House lawn in Washington, DC with President Obama and First Lady Michelle Obama.



Coco Montrese originally from Miami, Florida, she was born in 1992. She performed in many different cities in the USA. Held the title of Miss Gay America 2010. Top 5 of Rupaul's Drag Race Season 5. Now residing in Las Vegas Nevada and being part of such an amazing cast in the "Most Outrageous Female Impersonator Show" Frank Marino's Divas Show in Las Vegas Nevada.





Derrick Barry, at 19, was ready to see his name in lights. North Hollywood became his home for over a year, while he immersed himself in the entertainment industry. After dressing as Britney Spears for Halloween, not only did he shock Britney on "The Tonight Show with Jay Leno", he soon had the attention of West Hollywood nightlife, Hollywood movie producers & Las Vegas show producers. Las Vegas has been his home base since the age of 20, when he became the youngest cast member to join "An Evening at La Cage".

Barry has performed on the Las Vegas Strip for over 10 years and been featured on the cover of almost every single Vegas magazine publication. His spot on impersonation even led him to roles in Joseph Kahn's music videos for Katy Perry and Eminem. His most recent cameo includes Olivia Newton-John's #1 hit "You Have To Believe". He's traveled the nation following Britney's "Circus" a "Femme Fatale" tours and performed in over a dozen countries. Barry starred as Britney & Gaga in "Divas Las

Vegas" from 2009 - 2015. He now only appears for special occasions due to his tour schedule. Barry even had a two year residency at Share Nightclub, following Britney's "Piece Of Me" show. He was honored to walk the runway for her costume designer in MarcoMarco's Spring Season 2015 Collection 3 runway show for LA Fashion Week.

Barry made his TV acting debut starring as Julie on USA's "DIG" in 2015. More recently, he was cast as Kimberly in his first feature film, "War On Everyone" opposite Alexander Skarsgård, due out 2016. He starred opposite Nick Nolte in "Graves' also out in 2016. Derrick's latest TV role has him competing on season 8 of 'RuPaul's Drag Race'. Barry has his eyes set on film, television (SNL) & Broadway. He's eager to share his journey with the world through Reality TV & Documentaries. Derrick continues to display his facets in many lights. Just like a crystal, he shines in everything he does. He may be known for being Britney, but it's time the world gets to know Derrick Barry.



Established in 2009 by drummer, Dave Whitaker, the Pop Rox have become Knoxville's premier cover band! Building on the reputation for replicating spot on 80's covers, over the years the Pop Rox have expanded their catalogue to include various genres and decades to accommodate a vast listening audience. The success of the band can also be attributed to the boundless, no-holds-barred energy and charisma of singer,

Valerie Buckner. Besides performing regularly at local venues the Pop Rox have had to pleasure to perform for charity and corporate events, weddings and headline festivals. The Pop Rox are THRILLED to be back at Pridefest this year!!! and many more. Over their 10+ year career, the always outspoken duo has solidified themselves as community advocates with messages of gay rights and equality infused into their genre-defying sound. - The fastest-growing opera audience in the U.S. now is people in their 20s and 30s and today's composers are experimenting with opera to find new ways of keeping the art form alive.


